- 3. Met with each party, and his or her attorney?
- 4. Met with each child?
- 5. Did home visit at mother's home?
- 6. Did home visit at father's home?
- 7. Decided whether to request appointment of custody evaluator?
 - a. If yes, made motion for appointment?
 - b. Have list of experts to suggest?
- 8. Requested 2-5 letters of reference from people in support of each parent's claim for custody?
- 9. Received and reviewed reference letters?
- 10. Contacted the children's schools and/or daycares, teachers, babysitters, aides, etc.?
- 11. Investigated criminal background of each parent and significant others with whom the children may be living?
- 12. Have all hearing dates and trial dates scheduled on calendar?
- 13. Is there a deadline for me to make a recommendation to the court?
 - a. If so, what date?
 - b. If so, must it be in writing?
- 14. Thoroughly investigated any signs or allegations of child abuse or domestic violence?
 - a. Are there police reports?
 - b. What do the parents allege?
 - c. Are there signs that the children may have witnessed abuse of other children of a parent?
- 15. Thoroughly investigated any signs of substance abuse in family members?
 - a. Parents' DUI's?
 - b. Friends and neighbors, family members' allegations, intimations?
- 16. Written recommendation (if required) by deadline?
- 17. Contacted parties and their attorneys to see if there is a chance for settlement before trial?
 - a. If so, facilitate negotiations?
 - b. If settlement agreed on, prepare the document?
- 18. Have my witnesses subpoenaed for trial?
